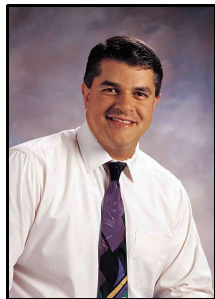

- Is there substantial evidence for human evolution, and should Christians abandon the historic Biblical view of human origins and embrace theistic evolution?
- Is theistic evolution scientifically supportable, and is it compatible with key Christian doctrines?
- Is it possible to develop a human origins model that incorporates the latest scientific advances while retaining the historic Christian view of humanity's creation?

In this presentation, Dr. Fazale Rana sets forth a creation model for human origins that integrates both the scientific data and the Biblical creation texts into a single framework. In the process, he demonstrates that harmony exists between the traditional Biblical view of human origins and advances in molecular anthropology and archaeology.
